Nepali or non-Nepali national with a 10+2 or intermediate or equivalent level study program of at least two-year duration in any discipline with minimum of **50 percent in aggregate or CGPA** of **2.0 on the scale of 4.0 and minimum 'C' grade in each subject** from a university/board recognized by Kathmandu University.
- 2. GCE Advanced Level students should have passed minimum three subjects in A Level and one general paper in AS Level with marks/grades requirements as mentioned above.
- 3. Regarding GCE Advanced Level students should have minimum C grade in each subject with minimum 50% (or CGPA 2.0 on the scale of 4.0). For example: if a candidate has achieved 52% but in one of the subject he/she has D grade is not eligible for BBA(Honors/Emphasis)/BBA/BBIS Admission.
- 4. Candidates having mark sheet with separate grading for practical and theory should have minimum grade C in each category (Theory and Practical).
- 5. Candidates should have achieved minimum 50% in send up exam in grade 12 the mark sheet of send up exam should be submitted while submitting the admission form along with other mark sheets.
